Dress Code

WALH STUDIOS' FACULTY TAKES THE TRAINING WE PROVIDE SERIOUSLY.

OUR DRESS CODE CREATES AN ADDED SENSE OF DISCIPLINE IN THE CLASSROOM, AND EQUALITY AMONG THE STUDENTS. THE FOCUS STAYS ON TAKING A GOOD CLASS RATHER THAN COMPARING WARDROBES.

ALL DANCE & MUSICAL THEATRE CLASSES:

No street shoes will be allowed in the dance rooms. Likewise, dance shoes should not be worn outside before or after class. HAIR MUST BE UP OFF THE NECK, AND AWAY FROM THE FACE. PONYTAILS ARE ACCEPTABLE FOR CLASS.

GIRLS DANCE ATTIRE: LEOTARD AND TIGHTS (ANY COLOR - NO TWO-PIECE, MUST BE FULL LEOTARD)

*NO SHIRTS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED AS A COVER UP, EXCEPT WALH TANK OR PLAIN BLACK TANK WORN OVER A LEOTARD.

TIGHT-FITTING DANCE PANTS AND DANCE SHORTS (WITH TIGHTS) MAY BE WORN TO MOST DANCE CLASSES, AT THE TEACHER'S DISCRETION.

NO PAJAMA BOTTOMS. NO BAGGY CLOTHES. FOR BALLET CLASSES: NO PANTS OR SHORTS. BALLET SKIRTS MAY BE WORN.

BOYS DANCE ATTIRE: TEE SHIRT (NON-OFFENSIVE) AND BLACK ATHLETIC PANTS. NO SHORTS. NO PAJAMA BOTTOMS.

SHOE REQUIREMENTS

SPECIFIC STYLE AND COLOR OF DANCE SHOES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS. DANCE SHOES CAN BE PURCHASED AT DANCE SPECIALTY STORES SUCH AS BAILEY SLIPPER SHOP, IN ORCHARD PARK.

REFER-A-FRIEND

ALL CURRENT WALH STUDIOS FAMILIES THAT REFER A FRIEND TO REGISTER WILL RECEIVE A ONE TIME \$10 DISCOUNT OFF THEIR COSTUME BILL. NEW REGISTRANT MUST INFORM WALH STUDIOS OF REFERRAL WITH CURRENT STUDENT'S NAME IN A NOTE TO WALH STUDIOS, IN ORDER TO BE GRANTED DISCOUNT. THE DISCOUNT IS PER EACH NEW FAMILY (NOT STUDENT), BUT THERE IS NO LIMIT TO THE AMOUNT OF CREDITS THAT CAN BE APPLIED TO AN ACCOUNT.

COSTUMES

Students enrolled in dance and musical theatre classes will be required to purchase one costume per class.

COSTUMES WILL BE ORDERED IN LATE NOVEMBER TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARRIVE IN TIME FOR OUR ANNUAL RECITAL.

Broadway Babies costumes are \$65. / Costumes for 6-8, 9-12, and 13+yr. Old classes are \$75.

- ♦ YOU MUST PAY THE ENTIRE BALANCE ON OR BEFORE **NOVEMBER 15TH.** YOU MAY MAKE <u>COSTUME PAYMENTS</u> ANY TIME BEFORE **NOVEMBER 15TH** BY CASH, CHECK, OR CC.
- **STUDIO POLICY: AS OF NOVEMBER 15™, ALL COSTUME BALANCES WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CHARGED TO THE CARD ON FILE.
- ♦ COSTUME FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AS OF NOVEMBER 15TH.

TIGHTS

ALL DANCE AND MUSICAL THEATRE FEMALE STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A NEW PAIR OF TIGHTS, EACH YEAR, SPECIFICALLY FOR PICTURE DAY AND THE RECITAL, IN ORDER TO HAVE A PROFESSIONAL LOOK TO OUR SHOW. TIGHTS COST APPROXIMATELY \$12-16 PER PAIR. ORDERS WILL BE PLACED IN FEBRUARY OR MARCH. BOYS WILL NEED BLACK SOCKS FOR PICTURE DAY AND PERFORMANCES.
